Students were made to verify the drawn perpendicular line with the help of a protactor. A pattern of drawing a perpendicular line is generated by the help of paper cutting and then pasted on the paper. By this way the perpendicular lines were obtained. Overall, it was a wonderful learning experience for the students.

CLASS VII

Topics covered: An exterior angle is equal to the sum of the two interior opposite angle in a triangle.

SCIENCE

CLASS VI

Aim : To show that handspan is not a standard unit to measure length. This activity was conducted in class VI with the help of a table or desk and ruler . Three students measured the



length and breadth of a table with their handspan and then with the help of a ruler.Measurement with handspan were not equal. Students came to know that handspan is not a standard unit to measure length,So the standard unit of measurement is metre not handspan

CLASS VII

Aim : To study the conditions necessary for rusting. This activity was conducted in class VII with the help of iron nails, water and beaker . The students dipped the iron nails in water for two or three days . A reddish brown flaky layer



deposited on iron nails and this layer is known as rust. After this

activity students came to know that when iron articles were exposed to air having moisture they get rusted. Students participated pro actively in class.

CLASS VIII

Topics covered: Force and Friction

An activity to show that force exerted by sliding friction is greater than force exerted by rolling friction was conducted in class on August 21, 2018. Students were enthusiastically engaged in the activity and learned the concept of sliding friction and rolling friction. They understood the concept using different materials like books, ruler, pencil etc and concluded that sliding friction is greater than rolling friction by performing this activity.

SOCIAL SCIENCE

CLASS VI

Topic covered:- Mughal Sultanate The students of class 6 performed the activity to show the SIX IMPORTANT EMPERORS OF MUGHAL SULTANATE . They observed the work and time period of each emperor.
